Further, total 6 appeals were received in the month of February and 03 appeals received in the month of January were carried forward in the month of February totaling comes to 09 appeals and total 3 appeals were disposed off in the month February and 06 appeals were carried forward in the month of March. In month of March, 03 appeals were received totaling 09 appeals. Out of 09 appeals, 08 have been disposed off leaving 01 appeal pending for the month of April.
