1. Thirty Eight applications were transferred from Ministry under Section 6(3) of RTI Act-05 and application fees were retained in the Ministry
2. Three applications were received under BPL family
3. One application was transfer C O , KVIC,Mumbai to D O KVIC, Madurai Office and one application was transfer from Chennai office and retained application Rs.10/- each in respective offices respectively.
3. First Appellate Authority vide letter No FAA/RTI/2014-15, dated 08/04/2014 has informed that total 8 appeals were received in the month of January, 2014. However, 5 pending appeals for the month of December were carried forward and disposed off in the month of January alongwith 5 appeals received in the month of January 2014 hence, total disposal of appeals in the month of January comes to 10. Further total 6 appeals were received in the month of February and 03 appeals received in the month of January were carried forward in the month of February totaling comes to 09 appeals and total 3 appeals were disposed off in the month February and 06 appeals were carried forward in the month of March. In month of March, 03 appeals were received totaling 09 appeals. Out of 09 appeals, 08 have been disposed off leaving 01 appeal pending for the month of April
